ORDER

1. Three Mercy Chances for External Examinations have already been granted to B.Tech students of various batches (both Regular and Part Time) by relaxing clauses pertaining to maximum duration in the B.Tech Regulations 2000 and 2007, vide paper read 1 above.
2. As per paper read (3) above, B.Tech students of various batches (Regular/ Part Time) who could not successfully complete the programme, due to several reasons, has requested to grant one more chance to appear for the B.Tech Examination
3. Based on the request of B.Tech students to conduct mercy chance examination for the fourth time, the remarks of Examination Branch was sought and the Examination Branch vide paper read (4) above intimated that the same shall be conducted without effecting the already scheduled examinations as per the Examination calendar, subject to the approval of the Academic Council.
4. The Syndicate held on 25.10.2024 vide paper read 5, considered the matter and resolved to refer it to the Academic Council
5. The XXIXth meeting of the Academic Council, held on 21/12/2024 vide paper read 6, considered the request of the B.Tech students to grant one more mercy chance (External) Examination and approved the same and further resolved to place the matter of fixing the fee before the Syndicate.
6. Subsequently, the meeting of the Syndicate held on 21/03/2025 vide paper read 7, **resolved to fix the re-registration fee as Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) and course wise fee as Rs.2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only).**
7. The above resolution of the Syndicate has been implemented.

8. Therefore, in view of the resolution of the Academic Council (vide paper read 6) and resolution of the Syndicate (vide paper read 7), which are implemented in the University, **sanction has been accorded to conduct One Time Mercy Chance Examinations (External) for B.Tech candidates of various batches from 2000 admission onwards (both Regular and Part Time) by levying the re-registration fee of Rs.5000/- (Rupees five thousand only) and Rs.2000/- (rupees Two thousand only) for each paper (course) .**
9. The Examination Branch shall initiate further steps to notify the Examinations accordingly.

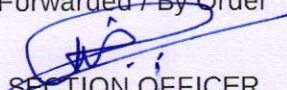
